RANGEMASTER NOTICE

Being a Range-Master is a privilege granted to you for your commitment to perform a minimum of five hours of work duty during the year.

FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF YOUR RANGEMASTER STATUS!

The WCSC Executive Board voted to amend the Rangemaster program to state that R/M's will no longer be required to be on duty on weekends. Any member using the outdoor ranges must be certified as a WCSC Range-master or be accompanied by a Rangemaster.

In lieu of weekend range duty R/M's will fulfill their commitment by signing up for a work crew. All R/M's are required to attend one of the update sessions in January or February each year.

Follow-up sessions will be scheduled through the Head Rangemaster.

WCSC Club Officers have the authority to control the ranges as needed. Club officers are identified by their *orange* membership card.

To Avoid Conflicts Please Check your family schedule BEFORE picking work date! Since your group is counting on you, if something does arise you must notify the Head Rangemaster &/or the committee head. You will automatically be rescheduled to the next months General Work Date and expected to be there.

Regular Monthly Work Day is the First Saturday of the Month 8:30 am April through November. Check the Website for updates.

Depending on your selected committee and work duties be sure to check to see what special equipment, tools, items that may be helpful to have on hand.

Be advised that the outdoor ranges may have to be closed while work is being performed.

Security cameras are in place on all ranges & clubhouse so be sure to S-M-I-L-E!!

Any member found to violate the safety rules set forth or participate in any dangerous activity may result in revocation of their membership!

Retain your current membership card as lock combinations will not change until February $17^{\rm th}$.
